Riverboat *Discovery III*

Alaska’s history comes to life when we board an authentic sternwheeler and observe an Alaskan bush pilot take off and land, and watch a champion sled dog demonstration from the kennels of the late Susan Butcher, four-time Iditarod winner. We disembark and are immersed firsthand in frontier living with a guided walking tour of a recreated Athabascan Native camp to discover how the Athabascans skillfully survived for over 10,000 years.

Kenai Fjords National Park Narrated Cruise

The experienced captain will fully narrate your journey and provide information on the area's wildlife, history, and geology. View a towering active tidewater glacier and watch for possible calving, where chunks of glacial ice break off and crash into the water. If possible, the crew will pull a small floating iceberg onboard to admire the detailed construction and beauty. Watch for wildlife such as orca whales, humpback whales, Steller sea lions, harbor seals, puffins, eagles, and many species of seabirds.



Denali National Park

Denali National Park and Preserve (formerly Mount McKinley National Park) is one of Alaska's 17 national parks and 16 national wildlife refuges. Denali National Park is home to Denali, North America's tallest mountain, which at a height of 20,320 feet, is often shrouded in clouds. It's a treat when conditions are favorable and we can see the peak in all its glory. The park landscape is a mixture of forest and tundra as elevation rises. When possible, the bus displays live video footage of wildlife along the Denali Park Road with drop-down video screens so you can see the action. Tour drivers are educated and trained as interpretive Naturalists and provide enriching introductions to the landscapes, geology, and history of the park including why protecting Dall sheep was the primary motivation for creating Mount McKinley National Park in 1917.





Alaska SeaLife Center

This is the only facility in Alaska that combines a public aquarium with marine research, and education as well as wild-life rescue and rehabilitation. Witness a Steller sea lion glide past underwater viewing windows, and puffins diving in a carefully crafted naturalistic habitat. Learn about the life cycle of Alaska's Pacific Salmon and be sure to stop by the Discovery Touch Tank and feel the prickly and squishy living tide pool creatures that call Alaska's water's home!

General Information

Guaranteed Prices Holiday Vacations' published tour prices are based on the rates known at the time of publication and are expected to be in effect at the time of departure. Once we have received your deposit, your price is guaranteed and any subsequent price increase is at our expense.

Reservations Make reservations well in advance. Space requested by phone will be held for five business days pending receipt of the required deposit by mail, telephone, or in person. Reservations made after the indicated final payment due date must be paid in full at the time of reservation.

\$200 Deposit Per Person A deposit must accompany all reservation requests. Personal check, money order, Discover, MasterCard, or VISA are acceptable forms of payment.

Final Payment A balance due date and amount will be indicated on your tour statement. We accept credit cards but appreciate final payments to be made by check or money order.

Refunds Deposits and all payments are fully-refundable prior to the final payment due date. Holiday Vacations issues refunds via the payment method they were provided. (e.g. payments provided by check will be refunded with a check; payments provided by credit card will be refunded to that credit card.)

Children On Tour Children traveling on tour must be at least eight years old and accompanied by an adult.

Special Requests Individual requests must be made when booking. Requests for (non) smoking, special dietary needs, adjoining, handicap accessible, or other room types are subject to confirmation and cannot be guaranteed.

Hazardous Materials Federal law forbids the carriage of hazardous materials aboard aircraft, in your luggage, or on your person. A violation can result in five years imprisonment and penalties of \$250,000 or more (49 U.S.C. 5124). Hazardous materials include explosives, compressed gases, flammable liquids and solids, oxidizers, poisons, corrosives, and radioactive materials. Examples: Paints, lighter fluid, fireworks, tear gases, oxygen bottles, and radio-pharmaceuticals. Passport Required (FOR INTERNATIONAL TRAVEL) Your passport must be valid for **6 months** from the end date of your tour.
