REMINDER – No one person can hold the office of secretary and treasurer. The duties must be separated, and office held by different persons. If you have done this, it **must** be changed. One person--one office. If you need any assistance or have any questions, please feel free to contact me or the office.

This month's spotlight on Oasis Divan leadership takes us to the top of the boardroom table where you will find the elected offices of Potentate and Recorder. This month spotlight is on the elected position of Oasis Potentate. The 2022 position is currently held by Illustrious Sir Tim Daniels and will end December 31.

If you will take a few minutes to look back in several of my articles on the positions of 1st Ceremonial Master, who is appointed by the incoming Potentate and without any issues goes on to serve for two years as appointed and five years as elected. The planning for most Potentate's year starts 5 to 7 years in

After the December 3 elections, the current Potentate, Ill Sir Tim will be holding and attend two more official events of his term. The Gastonia parade on December 4th and the Club & Unit Appreciation Night.

Look for more details in the future, but for now remember to make your plans to attend the Club and Unit Appreciation to be held on Friday evening January 6th and the Installation of Noble Doug Garland and his "Team 23" on Saturday evening January 7th. Our host hotel is once again the University Hilton. Come out and say thank you to "22" and hello to "23".

I always like to close by remembering to thank GOD for all His glory, enjoy your family, stay safe, and be thankful every day for what you have and where you are. Hope to see you at Oasis or at an Oasis function soon. Until next month.

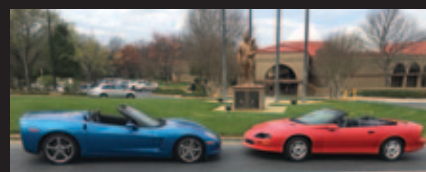

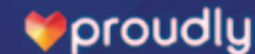

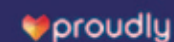
